



## LEFT HAND BREWING FOUNDATION GRANTING GUIDELINES

- **Mission Statement**
  - Founded in Left Hand's 20<sup>th</sup> year, the Left Hand Brewing Foundation (LHBF) is committed to brewing a stronger community where we work, live and play. The LHBF affords Left Hand Brewing Company, in partnership with the Longmont Community Foundation, the ability to respond quickly and efficiently, with financial support to issues and emergencies in Colorado and beyond.
- **Eligibility**
  - Organizations applying must be classified as a 501c3, or equivalent, by the Internal Revenue Service
  - Organizations must provide services relevant to issues and emergencies impacting the Longmont community and beyond.
  - Only one grant per organization per year will be considered.
  - Preference will be given to Longmont area organizations. Applying organizations should be providing necessary services in the greater Longmont area.
- **Restrictions**
  - Applications will not be accepted from organizations providing services outside the scope of the Left Hand Brewing Foundation Mission Statement.
  - No grants will be issued to fundraising campaigns, special event purposes, individuals, political candidates, motorsport or athletic teams.
- **Grant Amounts**
  - The Left Hand Brewing Foundation will consider grants up to \$50,000.
- **Application Process & Deadlines**
  - Applicants should follow the grant application outlined below.
  - Once completed, 1 typed or electronic copy of the proposal should be submitted to [Foundation@lefthandbrewing.com](mailto:Foundation@lefthandbrewing.com) or Left Hand Brewing Foundation, 1265 Boston Avenue, Longmont, CO 80501
  - Please note that an application form does not guarantee award (in part or full).
  - Grants will be issued within 30 days from the approval of your application.
- **Notifications**
  - Only organizations of approved grants will be notified
  - If a grant is awarded, a completed letter of agreement will be required.
  - Grants will be awarded on a case by case basis.
  - All decisions by the Left Hand Brewing Foundation Board of Directors are final.
  - If organizations are unable to use the grant funding as described in the application, the awarded money will be refunded to the Left Hand Brewing Foundation immediately.
